13. Important events conducted by your KVK during the reported month:

(I) Brief Report:

Krishi Vigyan Kendra Srinagar organized SANKALP SE SIDDHI (Determination to attainment) programme at SKUAST-Kashmir on 29th of August 2017. The programme started with welcome address by Dr Rekhi Singh, Programme Coordinator who highlighted the main points of the program and how to double the income by various means like Production through improved seeds, planting material, Organic farming, Soil health cards, strengthening ware housing and cold chain facilities, online marketing of produce, crop insurance, more crop per drop and integrated farming system. Hon'ble Member Parliament Srinagar, Dr Faroog Abdullah graced the occasion as chief guest. 650 farmers/farm women from different parts of Srinagar district viz; Faqir Gujri, Tailbal, Nadirgund, Harwan, Nowgam, Lasjan, Khonmoh, Zewan, Rambir grah, Gulzarpora, Noorbagh, Khansahib and adjoining areas participated in the programme. Literature in Urdu about the programme was distributed among the farmers.
