13. Important events conducted by your KVK during the reported month:

(I) Brief Report:

(Soil Health Day)

The Krishi Vigyan Kendra Srinagar (SKUAST-K) organized "World Soil Health Day" at its campus Nambli Narkara Srinagar on 5th of December 2017. A large number of farmers from District Srinagar attended the event. Director Central Institute of Temperate Horticulture, Old Airport Srinagar. Dr.D.B.Singh graced the occasion as chief guest and stressed on the importance of soil health to get sustainable production. Dr.F.A.Zaki, Dean Horticulture SKUAST-K was the guest of honor who applauded the role of KVK in organizing the event. Dr Rekhi Singh, Programme coordinator delivered the welcome address briefly appraised the farmers about the purpose of organizing the Soil Health Day. A folder on "Fasloon ki behthar pidavar key liya miti ki janch ka tareeka aur ahamiyat" in Urdu was released and distributed among the farmers.

To make the above programme a success KVK organized Soil Health Week w.e.f 29th of Nov. to 5th of Dec. 2017. The week long programme was attended by 30 Extension Functionaries of line departments (Agriculture and Horticulture). Two field days were organized to demonstrate the trainees the site selection, collection of soil samples in farmer's field and analysis of soil samples for 16 parameters using Merdaparakshik in the soil testing lab of KVK. In addition to these lectures on importance of soil analysis, vermin-composting, poultry farm waste management, Permaculture and nutritive value of vegetables and fruits were delivered by scientists of KVK.

About 250 Soil Health Cards were distributed among the farmers and 30 certificates of participation among extension functionaries were also distributed. The chief guest

appreciated the efforts put in by KVK Srinagar for the benefit of farming community. The programme ended with Vote of thanks from Dr. Uzma Bashir, Soil Scientist.
