13. Important events conducted by your KVK during the reported month:

(I) Brief Report:

Kendra organised **National Nutrition week w.e.f 1st to 7th Sept. 2017.**

The programme was organized in different villages of District Srinagar where awareness was created among farm women, pregnant and lactating mothers, school children and elderly women. The programme was organized at International Islamic school, Peerbagh, Srinagar in which all the staff members of KVK, Srinagar, about 50 students (Girls and Boys) and 10 teachers participated. The participants were given first hand information/awareness regarding the importance and use of nutrition in human diet. On 6th of September 2017, programme was organized in collaboration with Aganwadi Centers at Gulzarpora and Rengreth where more than 50 Farm women, Elderly women, Pregnant, Lactating mothers and their Children participated in the said event. The participants were given awareness about nutritional requirements as per their need. They were given information about presence of different nutrients in cereals, vegetables, fruits and milk and milk products by scientists of the Kendra. On 7th of September 2017, programme was organized at Girls Higher Secondary School Kothi Bagh, Srinagar where more than 60 girl students of 11th and 12th class along with teachers and their Principal participated in the said event. The participants were given awareness about National Nutrition Week, PowerPoint Presentations about role of nutrients in balanced diet, role of vegetables, fruits, spices and milk and milk products & live stock. Free literature in English as well as in Urdu about benefits of taking milk during pregnancy was distributed among the participants for their information and knowledge. The programme was concluded by getting feedback from students and teachers. The programme was given due media coverage. At the end Programme Coordinator of the Kendra thanked the participants with the hope that they will benefit from the nutritional values of agricultural/ horticultural/ dairy products for their better health.
