#### (Animal Welfare Fortnight)

The Krishi Vigyan Kendra Srinagar (SKUAST-K) Celebrated "Animal Welfare Fortnight" w.e.f 14<sup>th</sup> of January to 30<sup>th</sup> of January 2018 at villages: Guzarbal, Bagilali-Pandit, Gagarzoo, Shunglipora, Nadurgund, Peerbagh, Palpora, Noorbagh and KVK Campus. More than 150 farmers (dairy, sheep and poultry) were benefitted in the programme. Following suggested activities were implemented during the said event.

- Training of Goshala personnel to utilize full potential of cow dung and urine for Vermi-composting.
- Anti-Rabies (AR) programme for controlling of stray dog population.
- Organized first- aid camps and 20 injured cases were treated at KVK campus.
- Grain and water was given to birds in the neighborhood.
- Anti-plastic bag campaign was done.
- Dairy farmers were made aware regarding the "Oxytocin and its Misuse"
- Sheep Clinic Camp was organized for diagnosis of different diseases and their treatment.
