01	500	02	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> For long term storage of apple spray 25 days before harvest, Mancozeb 75 WP (300 g/100 L of water) or Captan 50 WP (300 g/100 L of water). To improve storability of apple fruits, spray calcium chloride @ 5g/Liter of water 30 days before harvest or dip the fruits in 4% calcium chloride solution 5 minutes before packing. For management of sun burn in apple trees, white wash with a mixture of CuSo4 (60 g) + Hydrated lime (1.5 kg) + Glue (250 g) dissolve in 20 liters of water. Reduce sodium intake do away with table salt. Restrict intake of colas and chips among children- they can cause childhood diabetes and hypertension. Grow your own food stay away from pesticides/chemicals used in commercial grown vegetables.

(I) Brief Report
