
15. Important events conducted by your KVK during the reported month:

(I) Brief Report

A) 16th Scientific Advisory Committee (SAC) meeting of Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Srinagar was held on 2nd of September 2020 through virtual platform (Google Meet). The meeting was chaired by Prof. Nazeer Ahmad, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor SUAST-Kashmir and co-chaired by Prof. Mushtaq Ahmad, Worthy Director Extension SKUAST-Kashmir, Associate Director Agriculture Extension, District officers from development departments, Scientists of KVK and progressive farmers participated in the meeting. Senior Scientist and Head KVK, Dr. Rekhi Singh presented Action Taken Report, Annual Progress Report of 2019-20 and Annual Action Plan 2020-21. Hon'ble Vice chancellor appreciated the progress made by the Kendra and emphasized on development of KVK farm as a model for urban and peri urban areas. He also stressed for promotion of floriculture, vertical gardening and organic farming in the Dal Catchment area and integrated farming models for doubling farmer's income.
